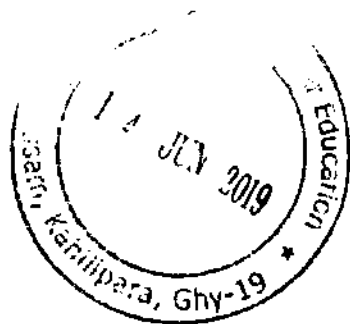

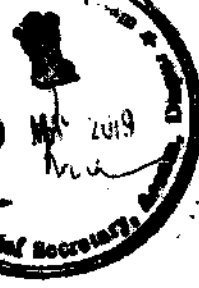

The UN General Assembly in a Resolution passed in December, 1987, proclaimed 26th June of each year as the "International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking". In pursuance of this declaration, every year, 26th June is observed all over the world to raise public awareness regarding menace of drugs. Governments use this occasion to spread awareness among the public regarding steps taken against drug abuse and illicit trafficking.

2. It is therefore, requested that necessary directions may be given to the concerned departments like Education, Health & Family Welfare, Social Welfare, Transport, Police, Jail, Youth & Sports, Excise & Prohibition in your State to organize various programmes on 26th June, 2019. Similar instructions may also be issued to District Magistrates/ District Collectors and Superintendents of Police. The programmes could include the following:-

- Awareness programmes in schools and colleges.
- Anti-drug Marches/Runs/Rallies.
- Public meetings especially targeting groups vulnerable to drug abuse and HIV (Street Children, Jail inmates, Truck drivers, etc).
- Seminars on drug abuse.
- Workshops to evolve new coordinated strategies for supply reduction and demand reduction by various government agencies/ civil society organizations.
- Exhibition on drug abuse.
- Flashing of SMS through various service providers.
- Regional language programmes on Doordarshan/All India Radio and other electronic media.
- Display and distribution of banners, posters, pamphlets, hoardings.
- Slideshow/Advertisement in cinema halls.

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3. It is suggested that the activities by various departments/agencies on the occasion of 26th June, may be continued for a fortnight, as in many of the states, schools and colleges remain closed on 26th June due to summer vacation.

4. The States/UTs may consider approaching Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, Govt. of India to grant under Section-7A of NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) to organize awareness programmes against drug abuse.

5. The Narcotics Control Bureau would appreciate a feedback on various programmes organized in the State on the International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking.

The State Level Function of IDY will be held at Guwahati.



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MINUTES OF THE MEETING FOR CELEBRATION OF 5TH INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA, 2019 HELD IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, NATIONAL HEALTH MISSION, ASSAM (NHM) ON 15.05.2019 AT 12.30 P.M.

Members present - As per Annexure-A

A meeting to discuss on the celebration of 5th International Day of Yoga, 2019 was held on 15th May, 2019 at 12.30 PM in the Conference Hall of the National Health Mission, Assam under the Chairmanship of Sri Samir Kr. Sinha, IAS, Principal Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Health & FW Department.

At the outset the Principal Secretary to the Govt. of Assam, Health & FW Department, informed that the State level function of IDY is to be held at Guwahati. He stressed on the co-ordination of all concerned departments for successful celebrations of IDY 2019. He also conveyed that the Hon'ble Chief Minister & Hon'ble Minister of Health & FW, Assam desired that celebration of International Day of Yoga at grassroot level be made in a befitting manner and activity report from grassroot be received.

After a threadbare discussion the following resolution were taken:

PWD	<p>through Common Yoga Protocol and for this purpose the services of the sports Associations can be used.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department will issue necessary instructions to the district officials to provide assistance/ support to the district authority as required. <p>It was informed that the Central function would be held in the Veterinary field, Khanapara.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The PWD (Building) Division, Guwahati will co-ordinate with Deputy Commissioner, Kamrup (Metropolitan) for preparation of the venue.

Department will mobilize students of class VIII & above to participate in the different level IDY Celebrations. Various Universities and educational Institutes will celebrate the IDY independently at their own centers. Education Department may issue necessary advising in this regard.
6.	Public Health Engineering Dept.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department will instruct officers and field staff to provide safe drinking water and basic sanitation facility in the IDY venues.
7.	Social Welfare Dept.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department will issue instruction to the field staff including Anganwadi Workers/ Supervisors to conduct awareness programmes about IDY at the ICDS facilities and also ensure their participation in nearest venue.
8.	Home Dept.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department will arrange necessary security arrangements in all the major venues including the central venue at Guwahati. The Department will issue necessary instruction to the concerned authorities to ensure active participation of Civil Defense personnel Police/APBN/Home Guards etc. to take part in the proximal IDY event.
9.	Transport Dept.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department will provide transportation facility to the venues in consultation with the District authority.
10.	GDD/UDD (GMC/UI.B) Dept.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department will provide for engaging adequate Safai Karmacharies in the venues. The Department will provide adequate dustbins in respective venues & portable toilets wherever required.
