Revision of pay scales a per 7th UGC pay commission- matter regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the Govt. instruction for implementation of the 7th UGC pay revision in respect of all concerned stakeholders, the exercise of verification of individual fixation proposals with supporting documents as submitted by the concerned colleges is going on in full swing and every endeavour is being made to complete the task at the earliest.

Every individual fixation as reflected in the IPS as prescribed is being checked with reference to entries in service Book and other relevant documents submitted from the respective college and some cases of fixation have been rectified due to alteration of pre-revised basic pay as on 31st March 2016 as worked out as per usual procedure.

However, if any omission and commission is detected subsequently, the same will will be duly taken care of in due course of time as per rules and procedures.

Moreover, as regard recovery/adjustment of overdrawal of salary in any individual case, steps may kindly be taken by the respective Principals as the DDO by issuing order to allow suitable instalments for recovery/adjustment of the overdrawn amount out of admissible arrear amount worked out and/ or monthly instalment to be fixed for liquidation of entire amount.

I would also like to refer to the relevant Govt. instructions vide OM No. FM5/2010/02 dated 19-2-2010 and notification no. FM5/2010/29 dated 29-3-2012 regarding House Rent Allowance payable in case of both husband and wife working under different Govt. organisation in the same station.

As per Govt. instructions, only one house rent allowance will be admissible if both husband and wife are serving in the same station inrespective of their employment whether it is under Central Govt./ Central Govt. undertaking or State Govt./State Govt. undertaking and for a State Govt. employee to claim house rent allowance if his spouse is also employed under state Govt./State Govt. undertaking/ Central Govt./Central Govt. undertaking, the employee will have to furnish an undertaking to the effect that his spouse is not claiming any house rent allowance from his/ her employer.

Suitable steps for obtaining of undertaking as per Govt. instructions may kindly be initiated before drawal of house rent allowance of the Govt. servants concerned under your respective jurisdiction.
