

## Guidelines for providing Infrastructural Development grants to Govt. and provincialised Colleges in Assam

### Introduction:-

At present, the following category of Govt. and provincialised Colleges are functioning in Assam :

(a) Govt. Colleges	-	7Nos.
(b) Provincialised Colleges	-	189 Nos
(c) <u>Nalbari Sanskrit College</u>	-	1 No.
Total	-	197Nos. (list enclosed)

All the above mentioned 197 Colleges are running in their own institutional buildings constructed in their own plot of land. But the infrastructural facilities of all the colleges are not as per requirement of UGC norms.

The need of additional infrastructural facilities vary from college to college. Most of the colleges are running with shortage of class rooms. Besides requirement of additional class rooms, many colleges need hostels, auditorium, proper water supply, Electrification and Installation of electrical equipments, Improvement of Library and Laboratory, Internal roads and drainage system, etc. alongwith the boundary wall and playgrounds are also to be developed in almost all the colleges. Because of the infrastructural gap that prevails in the colleges of Assam, National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) at the time of accreditation has given the lower grade to many colleges of Assam. It may be stated here that most of the colleges are located in rural areas.

The Govt. of Assam has now decided to implement a Scheme to develop the system of teaching and learning in all educational Institutions of Higher Education in the state by creating digital class rooms. Many of the colleges in the state today do not have the benefit of experience and knowledgeable teachers in many of the academic disciplines and more specifically in the science streams. With a view to attract more and more students to study science in rural areas and to remove the bottleneck of possessing good and experience teachers in these colleges, digital interaction classes from a common place like Guwahati can be the one of the feasible alternative. And therefore for this purpose Govt. of Assam has decided to establish "Digital Classroom" and "Digital



Library" in all the existing colleges in Assam in phase manner. By establishing Digital Classrooms, arrangement can be made for providing lecturers by some experts teachers, which will be visible and audioable in all the educational Institutions of our state and the students and teachers of a college will be able to learn from these lecturers by sitting in their own college Digital Classrooms.

Besides establishing the Digital Classrooms a Digital Library will also be established in all the educational Institutions of our state. With the help of digital Library the students and teachers will be able to read all the books which are not available in their existing College Library. As a result the student and teacher community will be surely benefited. ✓

### Objectives:-

The main objective of the Scheme for providing infrastructural development grants to the Colleges :-

The Grant will be provided to the Colleges, on priority basis pertaining to the following aspects :

1. Priority will be given for construction digital class rooms to the Colleges which are operating with shortage of class rooms.
2. Improvement of Library and laboratory facilities.
3. Electrification & installation of electrical equipments to the College buildings and Hostels.
4. Preference will be given for construction of Girls'/Boys' Hostels.
5. Importance will be given for construction/installation of proper sanitary systems.
6. Priority will also be given for providing proper water supply systems to the Colleges.
7. Construction of boundary wall and improvement of playground/Play field, etc.
8. Construction/improvement of Internal roads and drainage system.
9. Any other bottleneck in infrastructure as identified by the College authorities or by State Government.

Methodology:-

A Model Detailed Project Report will be prepared by the Education Department for implementing the digital classroom and digital library Scheme on all the colleges. The implementation of the project will be as per Model Detailed Project Report. As regards, requirement for other infrastructural activities, the college authority will prepare and submit detail plan & estimate in consultation with state PWD and with PWD's countersignature should be submitted to Director of Higher Education, Assam. Director Higher Education, Assam will then submitted the demands to the State Govt. for necessary sanction.

Implementation of the work:

The infrastructural development works will be implemented through a construction committee which shall be constituted with the following members :-

All the measurement and records should be done by the State P.W.D. Department and bills have to be prepared by the State P.W.D. authorities. The Principal shall release the bill amount to the contractors with the approval of Governing Body of the College.

The Director, Higher Education, Assam will have the rights to verify the entire project execution.

Contingency :-

0.5% of the total budgeted amount will be kept by the Director of Higher Education, Assam to meet administrative cost like preparation of DPR, TA/DA etc. for visiting the project sites, convening of meeting, consultancy fees, etc.


