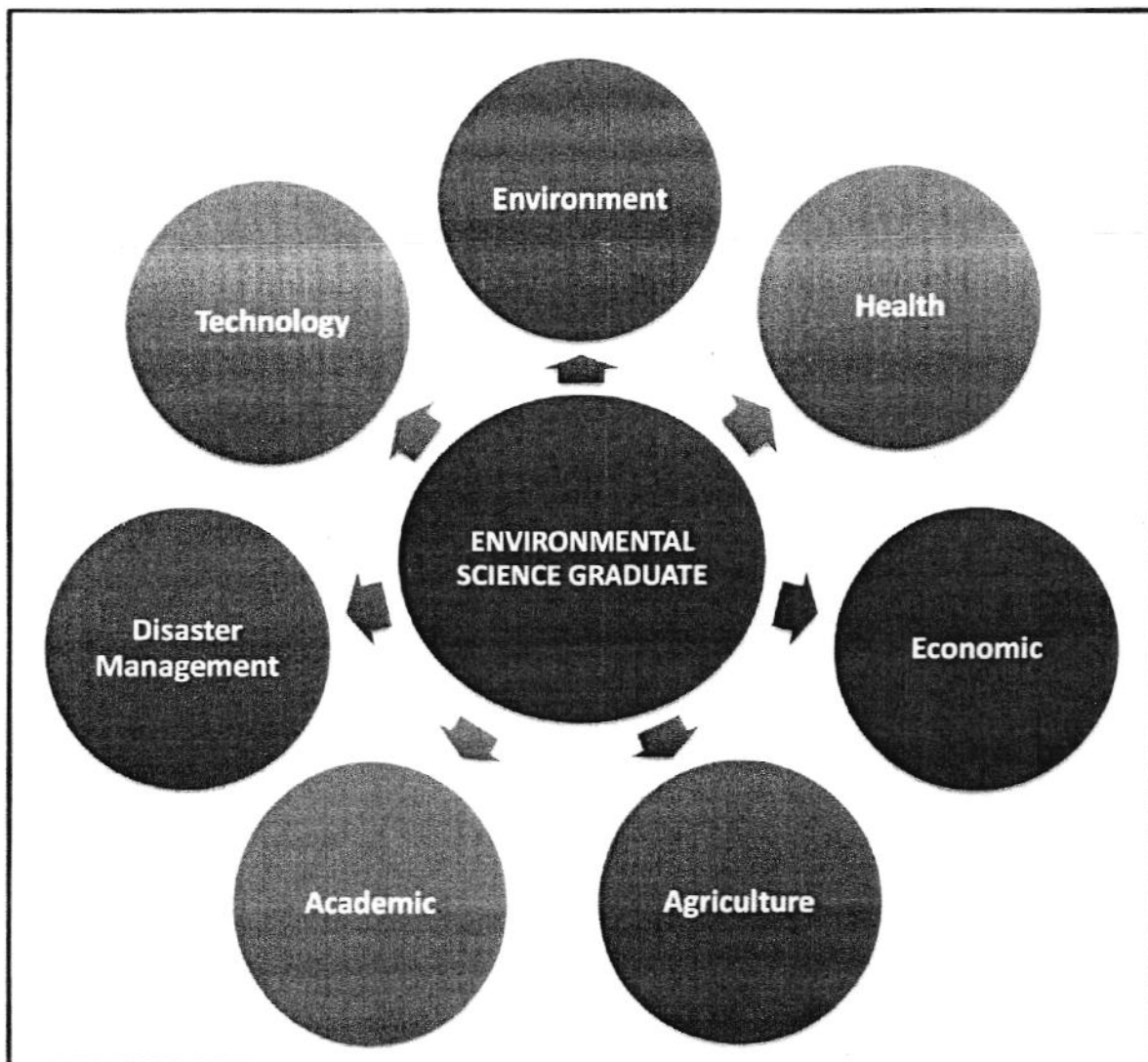

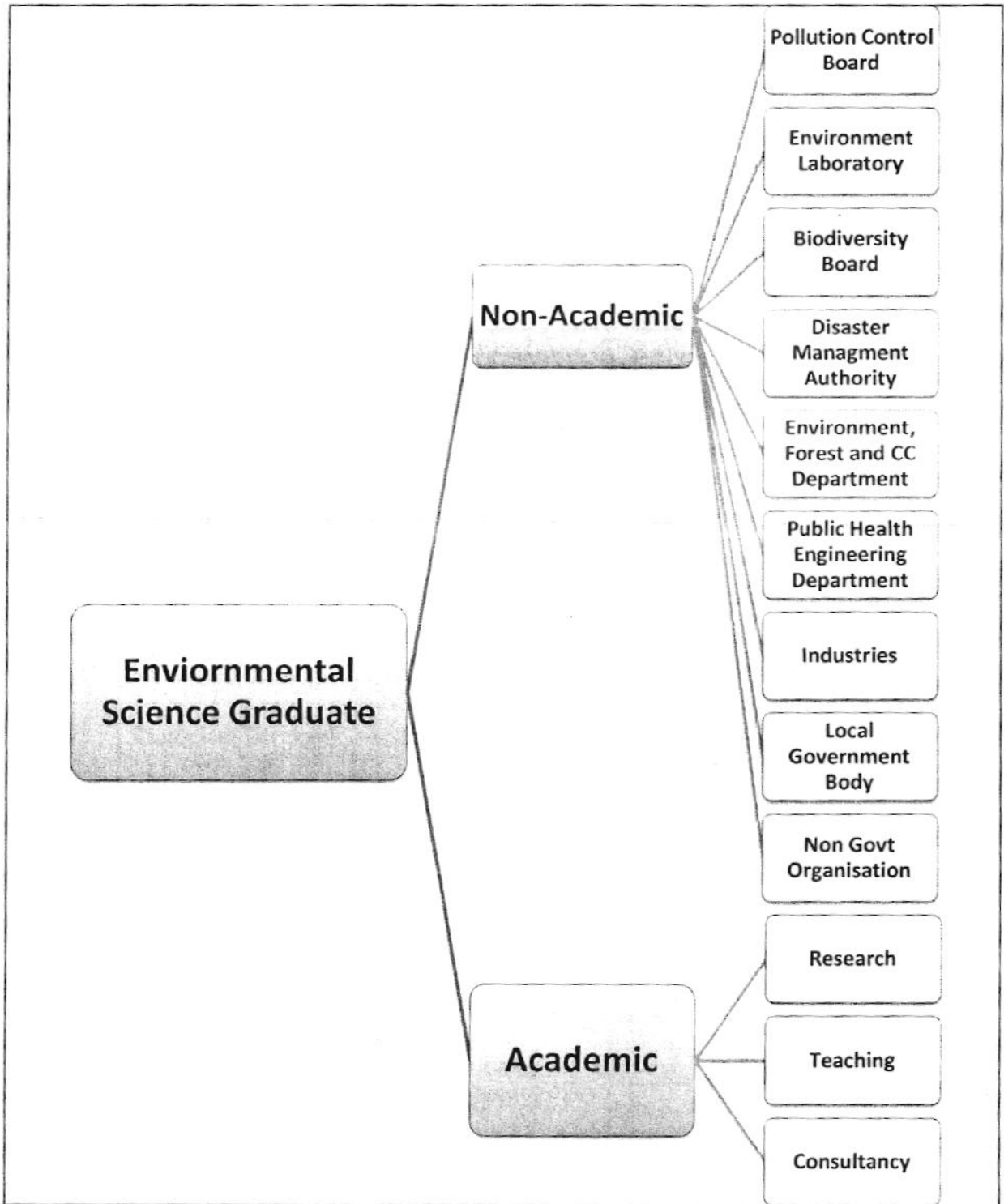
## Environmental Science Graduate: Scope and Opportunities

## ENVIRONMENT AND INDIAN CONSTITUTION

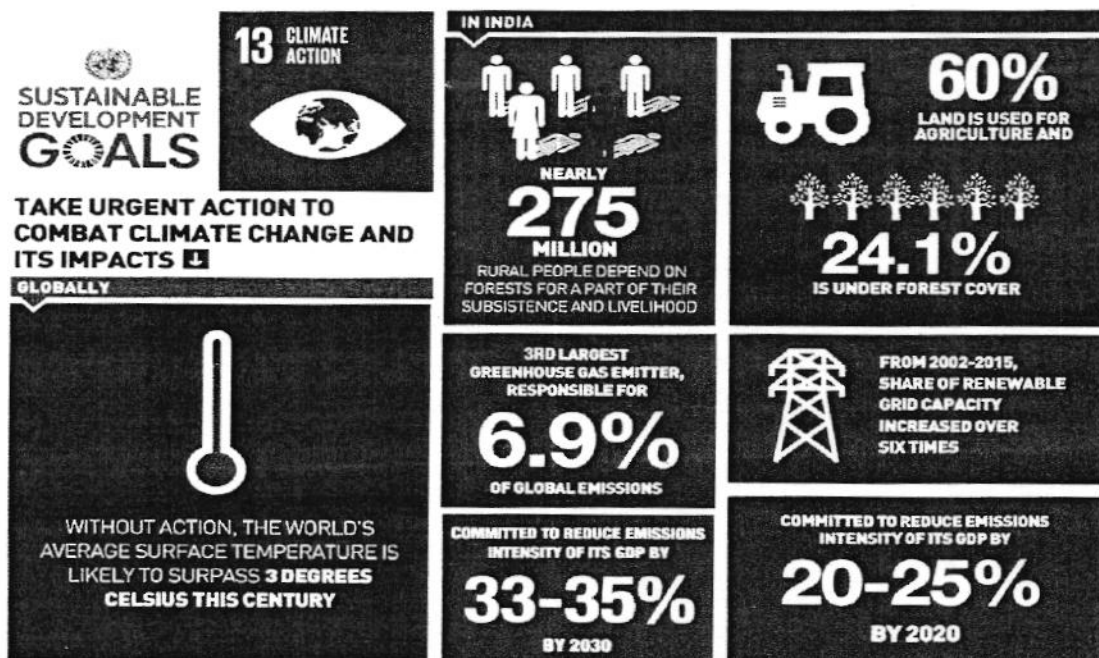

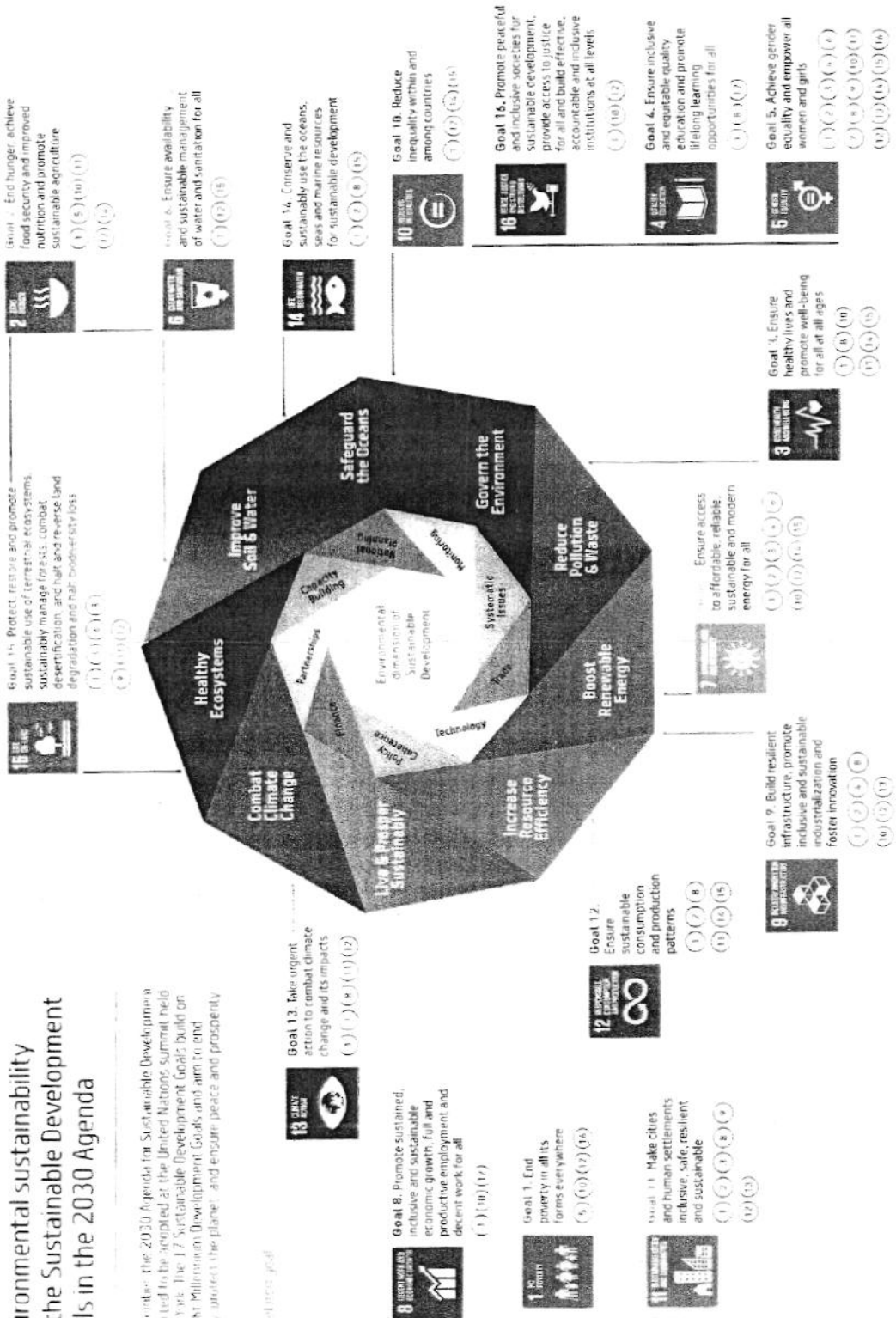
