

Our joint venture will also incorporate activities associated with Swach Bharat Abhiyan, personality development programmes, preservation of traditional cultural practices, creating awareness about and preservation of bio-diversity, eradication of superstitions, sharing of best practices, development of entrepreneurship based on local resources etc.

Borooah College, Guwahati on 22nd September, 2018 at 11 AM for inspiring the new generation of Assam in the spirit of patriotism and social responsibility! Activity Calendar of ACTA and VK For the session 2018-19

September 2018	Recitation and poster making competition among the college students of Assam to commemorate 125 th year of Swami Vivekananda's historic Chicago speech. Winners to be awarded in district level functions. A section among the awarded students to be selected for a training programme in Kanyakumari.
October 2018	District/Zone level training of both male and female college teachers in Yoga followed by a five days Yoga Satra and Personality Development Programme for students in every college. Weekly Yoga sessions to continue in the colleges.
November/December 2018	Deliberation and brainstorming among the Teachers/ VK Karyakartas for finalizing area specific social outreach programmes associated with Swach Bharat, cleanliness and hygiene in the local areas, yoga training in schools, anti superstition drives, skill and entrepreneurship development etc.
January 2019	College students/teachers to organize yoga training and associated academic, social and cultural activities in schools. Weekly yoga sessions to continue in the schools under the supervision of college teachers/students.
February 2019	Mass Suryanamaskar of School students under the jurisdiction of each college. Area specific skill development programmes for the local unemployed youths.
March	Meetings and gatherings involving students in the local market places and other public areas for enhancing awareness about cleanliness, garbage disposal, plantation and preservation of the environment.
April/May 2019	Continuation, review and collection of feedback on the ongoing programmes.
June 2019	Mass Plantation Abhiyan. Each student to plant two saplings. To seek cooperation of Social Forestry and to develop nurseries in the colleges for saplings for the purpose. Workshops to be organized on protection of environment and bio-diversity.
July 2019	Summer Yoga and personality Development programmes/camps for both college and school students.
August 2019	Essay and speech competition on issues related to Freedom Struggle.
