

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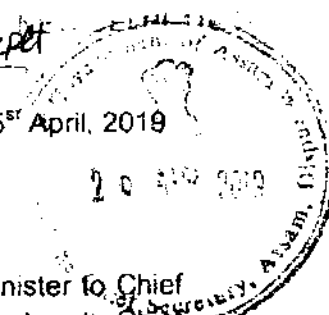

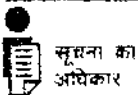

Minutes of the meeting for Mapping of Action points in Connection of 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi

Date- 09-10-18

Time: 4:00 PM

Members present: In Annexure 1

The meeting was presided by the Hon'able Chief Minister of Assam. He welcomed all the members present.

Agenda item no.1

The Commissioner and Secretary, Cultural Affairs, Mr. Preetom Saikia briefed about the objective of the meeting and briefed the meeting was about the mapping of action points by the various government departments in connection of the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.

Agenda item no.2

The Commissioner & Secretary, CAD, gave a Power-point presentation regarding the action points in connection with the 150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.

- Report of all the activities performed during the period between 2nd October, 2018 to 2nd October, 2020 will have to be submitted to the Central Government through the CAD of Assam which is the Nodal department for all the activities.
- Competition to be organized on play on Gandhiji to be held by schools and colleges during the period of 29th of Sept, 2018 to 2nd Oct, 2018. The activity has been completed.
Action: Education Department in association with the CAD.
- All the tableaux for the Republic Day Parade on January 26th, 2019 are to be based on the theme on Mahatma Gandhi. The selection of the tableau from Assam has already been made on the theme "*Sualkuchi Silk - Assamese Women Weave Dreams in Silk*".
Action: CAD.
- "*Special Pardon to Prisoners*" may continue during the entire period of commemoration i.e. till October 02, 2020. It will be implemented in 3 phases in Assam. On October 5th, 2018, 21 prisoners were released in the 1st phase.
Action: Home & Political Department/ IG (Prison)
- The suggestion of special session of Parliament and State assemblies will be scheduled by the Parliamentary Affairs department on Gandhiji's principles.
Action: Parliamentary Affairs Department.
- *Pada Yatra* to be organized involving 150 youths at a time walking for 10 Kms. per day for 150 days covering every village of the state. Similarly, a *Cycle Yatra* may also be organised. The Hon'ble Chief Minister opined that 4/5 youths from 33 districts should be selected for the *Cycle Yatra*. The group should cover the places of various ethnic groups/ communities in which cultural teams from within the local people will welcome the cyclists. During the Yatra, awareness to be generated on government programmes along with Gandhiji's teachings. Awareness can also be created on the effects of '*Drug Abuse*'. The Hon'ble Chief Minister advised that every village will have to be covered and the idea for the same has to be developed at the earliest. The "Route Map" for the *Pada Yatra* and *Cycle Yatra* should include people from all Castes and Communities, which will reflect the motto of "Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas". The Deputy Commissioner should be instructed to visit the areas prior to the Yatra, and select some Cultural Community Teams who will help the cycle yatra or pada yatra teams. The awareness activities should include the principles of Gandhiji.
Action: Department of Sports.
- Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat - 150 youths/students from one State should visit a partner state. Also, 150 students, maybe 5 from each state, should stay together for some time in camps. Under this activity, students from Assam will visit Rajasthan.
Action: Department of Sports
- Short film competitions will be organized on December 18th, 2018.
Action: CAD in association with MyGov.in
- A *Kavi Sanmilian* should be organised, which should cover various districts of the State and not just be Guwahati-centric.
Action: CAD
- ~~Top 150~~ Universities/ Institutions in the country should tie-up with top 150 international universities to organize conferences on Gandhiji. The Hon'ble Chief Minister opined that the

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~~Gujarati~~ University should tie-up with other top universities, especially from the ASEAN countries.

Action: Education Department (Higher)

- Quiz competitions will have to be organized for which the local quiz masters should be involved. The local cable networks have to be instructed to organize/broadcast the quiz competitions on their networks, where the parents of the competitors can also have an involvement.
Action: ~~Education Department (Higher)~~ in collaboration with the Department of I.T.
- A world record in cycling can be attempted. The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam instructed to collect data on the number of cycles from 26,000 villages and 1500 tea gardens in the State and to prepare a route-map so that we can get all the cyclists travelling at the same in order to attempt the World Record. Calls/messages need to be sent to motivate people through the Gaon Panchayats and GP & PS level.
Action: Department of Sports
- Campaign on Gandhiji's philosophy via Social media, Websites, Advertising Agencies will be done.
Action: Department of I.T.
- "Panchatantra" may also be included in the school syllabus for Value education proposal, and the necessary actions will be initiated.
Action: ~~Education Department (Primary/Secondary)~~
- Screening of films on Gandhiji to be organized by Jyoti Chitran on any historic date related to Gandhiji.
Action: Jyoti Chitran/CAD
- Activities for the upliftment of the Dalits to be initiated from next year.
Action: WPT & BC
- Proposal for solar energy as a non-conventional source to be sent to the Central Government. AEDA has already chalked out plans with 3 schemes on the installation of solar lights/ plants.
Action: Power/AEDA
- Restoration of water reservoir in mission mode and water conservation will be done.
Action: Water Resources Department.
- Projects for Specially-abled to be initiated.
Action: Social Welfare Department
- Dispute resolution by ADR through mediation, conciliation and Lok Adalat will be organized within the prescribed time-frame.
Action: Legislative Department
- In connection with the eradication of manual scavenging, all town committees will have cess pools, will be implemented within the specified time-frame.
Action: UDD/GDD
- Creation of awareness against violence/ crime against women/ vulnerable sections will be implemented.
Action: Home & Political/ Social Welfare/ Woman Commission
- Tree plantation initiatives will be organized within the specified period.
Action: Environment & Forest Department
- Health & Family Welfare will take necessary actions for the eradication of leprosy.
Action: Health & Family Welfare
- Initiatives will be taken to organize debates/essay/painting/quiz competitions by the schools.
Action: Elementary Education/Secondary Education

Agenda item no.3

The Hon'ble Chief Minister said that this is just the beginning. The focus will be on Gandhiji's philosophy and against consumption of liquor.

- Logo branding - There should be a logo of Gandhiji in Government posters, calendars, diaries, advertisements, etc. This activity is to be supervised by the Printing and Stationary Department.
- The Hon'ble Chief Minister directed the officials to know about the road-map of Gujarat on the implementation of the action points.
- The Hon'ble Chief Minister instructed to implement "Swachh Bharat" in State Medical Colleges frequently. The doctors can implement the initiatives of "Swachh Bharat" themselves in the district hospitals, sub-divisional hospitals, etc. on a daily basis. A programme should be chalked out for the sensitization of the attendants, ward boys, etc.

- Bio-waste should be sent for proper disposal. Daily cleanliness has to be maintained in all medical colleges of Assam. This can be taken up as a yearlong proposal. Discipline is to be maintained in all the hospitals because discipline is the main motive behind all these activities.
- Special programmes can be organised in the places of Assam where Gandhiji visited. Fifteen such spots can be developed as "Mahasthan" and activities should be taken up to build interest among the youths for these places and the history attached to them.
- Revival of the Muga plantations and weaving may be enhanced, based on Gandhiji's philosophy and his visit to Sualkuchi.
- Departments will prepare action plans based on Gandhiji's principles and these activities should be tagged with the normal programmes of all the departments.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.


