

**Subject: Regarding fight against drug and taking pledge to make drug free campus - reg.**

Sir,

1. The United Nations General Assembly in a Resolution passed in December, 1987, proclaimed 26<sup>th</sup> June of each year as the "International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking". In pursuance of this declaration, every year, 26<sup>th</sup> June is observed all over the world to raise public awareness regarding the menace of drugs. All Governments use this occasion to spread awareness among public regarding steps taken by Government against drug abuse and illicit trafficking in narcotics drugs and psychotropic substances. The role of various enforcement agencies engaged in fighting the menace of drugs is also highlighted on this day.

Narcotics Control Bureau, under the Ministry of Home Affairs being the nodal agency in the country in respect of Drug law enforcement and other related issues, has an objective to ensure that people of every sphere are informed about the harmful effects that the abuse of drugs can have on their health.
