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

You might be aware that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has directed time-bound implementation of the National Disaster Management Guidelines on School Safety through an order dated 14th August 2017 passed in the matter of Writ Petition No. 483 of 2004- Avinash Mehrotra Vs UOI.

- 2. Subsequent to above, NDMA issued the directions of the Supreme Court to all State Governments/UT Administrations vide letter dated 24th August 2017 regarding follow-up action to be taken in compliance with the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court in the said matter.
- 4. The 6th Meeting of the Joint Monitoring Committee (JMC) was last held on 23rd January, 2019 at NDMA to review the efforts taken by States and Stakeholders on implementation of the National Disaster Management Guidelines on School Safety Policy. A copy of the minutes of the meeting is enclosed for reference.
- The present status of the information received by NDMA from States/UTs is as under:
- a) NDMA has not received State Action Plan from Arunachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Manipur, Uttarakhand, West Bengal, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Lakshadweep.
- b) Quarterly reports for quarter ending December, 2018 have been received only from Bihar, Gujarat, Himachal Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tripura, Chandigarh & NCT Delhi. However the reports from rest of the States/UTs are still awaited.
- Details of Nodal Officers have not been received from Maharashtra.
- 6. States/UTs will send details on the methodology adopted to conduct safety audits (structural and non-structural) and the actions taken by the State/UT on the findings of the eafety audit in schools.

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- 7. In the Joint Monitoring Meeting held on 23rd January, 2019, it was also decided that the next meeting may be convened in April, 2019 with all the State Education Secretaries to review the actions taken by the States/UTs in the implementation of National Disaster Management Guidelines on School Safety-2016 and the Governments should be ready to submit the compliance report before the Hon'ble Supreme Court as the Hon'ble Court could take cognizance of the status in the matter any time. The date and venue of the meeting will be intimated in due course.
- 8. In view of above, you are requested to issue necessary directions to the concerned to expedite requisite reports. State Governments/UT Administrations are also requested to send Quarterly Report for the quarter ending 31st March 2019 to NDMA by 10th April 2019 with a copy to Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD).
