





Subject: The Presidential Award of Certificate of Honour to Sanskrit, Urdu, Persian, Arabic, Persian, Classical Oriya, Classical Kannada, Classical Telugu and Classical Malayalam Scholars and Mahatshi Badrayati Vyas Samman for young scholars in the same fields - Recommendations for the year 2019.

A scheme for the award of the Certificate of Honour was introduced in the year 1956 to honour the scholars of Sanskrit, Arabic and Persian Languages. The scheme was extended to cover Urdu, Oriya, Classical Kannada, Classical Telugu and Classical Malayalam in the year 2010. Certificate of Honour is awarded to Scholars of eminence over the years for their outstanding contribution in the field of Sanskrit, Arabic, Persian or Urdu/Persian. The scheme includes award of Certificate of Honour to the Scholar of eminence of any of the above languages. The scheme also provides for Mahatshi Badrayati Vyas Samman for young scholars in the age group of 30 to 40 years in the field of Sanskrit, Urdu, Persian, Arabic, Oriya, Classical Kannada, Classical Telugu and Classical Malayalam.

2. Further, from the year 2010 onwards, 32 more awards in Four Classical Languages (8 each) namely Classical Oriya, Classical Kannada, Classical Telugu and Classical Malayalam are also introduced. They are the Life time Achievement awards to scholars in India and also to those living abroad (foreign & Indian nationals) and Mahatshi Badrayati Vyas Samman for young scholars in these classical languages.

3. In this regard, it is stated that a certificate, a award and one time cash award as mentioned below are given to the awardees

- i. Rs. 10 lakh each for certificate of honour award
- ii. Rs. 50 lakh each for lifetime achievement awards (foreign & Indian national)
- iii. Rs. 10 lakh each for Mahatshi Badrayati Vyas Samman award

1991. Further, awards for the best research paper in Sanskrit, Kannada, Odia, Telugu, and Gujarati at Hyderabad will be given.

6. If any title or subject in any of the above mentioned languages, the nominee must have written in the classical phase of the language, even though the content of the title may be in modern form of language.

7. Recommendations for award may be made only for those young Scholars who have made a breakthrough in inter-disciplinary studies involving contribution of the rich ancient Indian wisdom, to the process of synergy between modernity of tradition and scientist & IT professional working for promotion of research in the language.

8. The recommendations should be clearly stating the specific achievement for which the award is recommended. The award should be sent along with character & antecedent certificate of the nominee in the prescribed format, to the Ministry by or April, 2002. The original certificate should be submitted to the Ministry. The last date will not be considered for the award. Commemorative copies of certificate (minimum) provided with the certificate should be submitted to the respective award committee by the nominee in the prescribed format. The award should be forwarded by the respective award committee to the Ministry through the Secretary of the Commission for the award.

9. Particulars in respect of the awards recommended for the award may be furnished in the attached proforma. In the absence of full details, it becomes difficult to give due consideration to the recommendations. It is, therefore, requested that full particulars may kindly be furnished in the prescribed format of the Commission.

10. It is also requested that while making the recommendations these observations, the awarding authorities should mention the individuals clearly for the purpose. There is no need to mention the name of the awarding authority. The awarding authority should be mentioned in the certificate. The awarding authority should be mentioned in the certificate. 


