NOTICE

This is to notify that to bring uniformity in the merit list preparation process, a uniform merit list preparation policy for UG admissions has been agreed upon by all the Universities and Autonomous colleges and was communicated to the undersigned.

Accordingly, all the affiliated colleges need to strictly follow the merit list policy as decided by the concerned Universities offering UG programmes, as per the annexure enclosed herewith. The Autonomous colleges and the Universities offering UG programmes will also follow the policy as per the same enclosure.

The merit list should be prepared **department-wise** based on the **choice of Major subject** against selection of **NEP stream**. In case of opting for three Minor option, merit list has to be prepared based on the **first Minor option** (applicable to affiliated colleges under Gauhati University). In case of selection of **NEP discipline specific**, the preparation of merit list will be as per the discipline subject chosen.

The seat allotment for every department will be as approved by the concerned University (in case of affiliated Colleges). In case of Autonomous Colleges and Universities offering the UG programmes, the seat allotment will be as per the data submitted.

The pre-requisites and eligibility criteria(s) already published in the Website/Information Bulletin of the Institutions for the students to see prior to admissions need to be factored in the preparation of merit list.

This is as per the merit list policy received from the Universities and Autonomous Colleges:

SERIAL NO	UNIVERSITY AND AUTONOMOUS COLLEGES	POLICY REGARDING PREPARING OF MERIT LIST
1	BODOLAND UNIVERSITY	Marks obtained in English shall be compulsory and marks obtained in any other 4 subjects from the subjects chosen by the candidates in H.S. final examination should be taken into consideration while preparing the list.
2	MADHABDEV UNIVERSITY	The merit list for admission into 1 st semester undergraduate programme 2023 would be prepared on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained in the Higher Secondary Final examination in five subjects including English.
3	GAUHATI UNIVERSITY	For preparing the merit list, the average of marks obtained in five subjects should be considered taking English as compulsory along with four other subjects (English + best of four subjects).
4	BHATTADEV UNIVERSITY	The criteria for merit list preparation for undergraduate level will be as follows:- 1) For State Board/ Council Marks secured in English+ Marks secured in MIL (or Alternative English) + Marks secured in best three from the other remaining subjects. 2) For CBSE Marks secured in English + Marks secured in best four from the Other remaining subjects.
5	DIBRUGARH UNIVERSITY	1) Best of five (05) subjects (English being the compulsory, viz. English + best of four subjects) shall be considered to prepare the Merit list for admission to the UG Programmes (FYUGP) through SAMARTH portal.
6	KUMAR BHASKAR VARMA SANSKRIT AND ANCIENT STUDIES UNIVERTSITY	1) Eligibility criteria - Candidates qualifying in HSSLC / HS (10+2) of any discipline or equivalent examination from any recognized Board. 2) Merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the qualifying examination. 3) Existing Govt. Reservation policy will be followed.
7	RABINDRANATH TAGORE UNIVERSITY	The merit list should be prepared by considering (4+1) out of 5 subjects of (10+2) where English subject will be mandatory. This criterion is taken as per common consensus which was discussed in online meeting held on 22 nd June, 2023.

8	MAJULI UNIVERSITY OF CULTURE	The inclusion of marks in one subject, namely English, is compulsory, while the best four subjects out of the remaining five will be taken into account for the purpose of preparing the merit list. High aggregate percentage shall be considered for preparing the merit list. Finally, Statutory reservation policy shall be followed as per the policy of the state Government.
9	FURKATING COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS)	Admission is on the basis of merit. The selection of students will be done by respective Departments on the basis of overall percentage in English and other best four subjects.
10	SIBSAGAR COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS)	1) Marks secured in English shall be considered compulsory. 2) Sum total of the best four other subjects out of remaining electives and MIL shall be considered as well as the marks secured in English. 3) Finally, the average of the five subjects shall be considered for preparing the merit list. 4) The reservation procedure shall be followed as per Government norms.
11	ARYA VIDYAPEETH COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS)	The marks obtained in English + best four (4) subjects.
12	J.B. COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS)	The merit lists of the applicants may be prepared by considering the total mark secured in HS Examination and that may be calculated by the accumulation of the individual marks secured in the following five subjects. 1) Marks secured in English - Compulsory Subject for all. 2) Four main subjects securing best marks.
13	NORTH LAKHIMPUR COLLEGE(AUTONOMOUS)	1) For the merit list, we would consider marks from five subjects in the class XII examination. 2) Out of five subjects, one will be English (Core), and the other will be the four best-performing subjects from the remaining five. 3) The above criteria will be the same for all subjects irrespective of the student's selection of the Major subject. 4) The reservations of seats will be as per the government policy.
14	NOWGONG COLLEGE (AUTONOMOUS)	The marks of Best of Five subjects from class XII board exams for preparation of the merit list.
