

MINUTES OF THE MEETING (VC) HELD UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF CHIEF SECRETARY, ASSAM ON 26.10.2022 AT 4.00 PM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF CHIEF SECRETARY, ASSAM IN CONNECTION WITH CELEBRATION OF RASHTRIYA EKTA DIWAS (NATIONAL UNITY DAY) ON 31ST OCTOBER, 2022.

October, 31st is being celebrated across the country as Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day) to commemorate the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the architect of national integration of independent India. It is a special occasion to foster and reinforce our dedication to preserve and strengthen the unity, integrity and security of our nation.

This year, it has been decided to organize 75,000 unity runs in 750 districts of the country involving people from all walks of the society. With a view to spread the message of national unity and spirit of Rashtriya Ekta and Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav through out the country, 100 unity runs per district are being organized to achieve the target of 75,000 unity runs. As a special initiative, various programmes focusing on national unity and integrity of our nation are also being organized at jails all over the country.

Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam took a meeting with the Chief Secretary, DGP and Departmental Officers today and issued specific directions for celebration of National Unity Day on 31.10.2022 in a befitting manner. This VC with DC/SP and other Departmental Officers is a follow up of the same.

The following points action points were discussed in the VC:

- 1) 3,500 unity runs to be organized in all the 35 districts of Assam. 100 unity runs to be organized in every District. However, in case of smaller Districts such unity runs will be organized as per their capacity. Such shortfall will be made up by bigger districts. Sports & Youth Welfare Department will assign specific targets to particular districts accordingly in consultation with DCs.
- 2) District Administrations will organize the runs involving the Sports & Education Departments.
- 3) Minimum 75 participants will have to take part in each run.
- 4) Rs. 10,000/- against each run to be disbursed to all the DCs by the Sports & Youth Welfare Department to organize the runs.
- 5) Superintendent of Police of the Districts will organize March Past through the major streets of their respective Districts in which DEF and Battalions will take part. The SPs will bear the cost of such runs from their own resources or through ADGP (SB).
- 6) All DCs will ensure that the pledge will be taken on 31st October, 2022 in all schools, colleges and Govt. Offices at 10.30 AM. Copy of pledge to be sent to all DCs by the Director, Sports & Youth Welfare, Assam.
- 7) Further, the District Administration and Police Department will have to make proper documentation of the event and submit the same to the Sports & Youth Welfare Department. Amtron will develop a portal for uploading of photos and videos and password/access will be shared with the DCs. The Director, Sports & Youth Welfare, Assam will take up the matter with AMTRON accordingly.
- 8) IG Prisons, Assam will organize various events focusing on national unity and integrity of our nation in the jails.
- 9) All DCs are requested to submit the Actual No. of Run to be organized by them to Sports & Youth Welfare Department by 11.00 AM tomorrow.
